

THE DR. MICHAEL A. PARLATO SCHOLARSHIP FUND
APPLICATION FORM

Dr. Michael A. Parlato was born in Derby, CT on December 19, 1885, son of the late Antonio and Antoinette Parlato. His parents were the first Italian settlers in Derby, in 1872. Dr. Parlato attended Derby public schools and was the first boy of Italian parentage to graduate from Derby High School, as a member of the Class of 1904. He graduated in 1908 from Yale University Medical School. He was also the first Italian American to graduate from Yale Medical School. He interned for two years at St. Raphael's Hospital. Dr. Parlato opened a private practice in Derby in 1910. He was an attending surgeon at Griffin Hospital until 1921. In 1921, he built and operated a private hospital at 270 Elizabeth Street, Derby. He closed the hospital in 1927, but maintained a private office at that location and was the senior surgeon at Griffin Hospital. He remained in active practice until 1965. In 1967, Dr. Parlato established an annual scholarship award for Derby High School graduates.

Purpose

“This trust is created and shall be operated exclusively for religious, charitable, scientific, literary or education purposes, or for the prevention of cruelty to children or animals with the United States or any of its possessions. It is the hope of the Donor that that the Board of Selections as hereinafter described will give primary consideration toward helping residents of Derby who otherwise qualify, to further their education whether the same be academic or professional fields.”

Eligibility

To be eligible to receive a scholarship, the applicant must satisfy all of the following criteria for the

Dr. Michael A. Parlato Scholarship Fund:

- Must be a resident of City of Derby
- Must be a student at the Derby High School for at least four years
- Must be a member of the graduating class of said Derby High School
- The applicant must possess financial need.
- The applicant must have demonstrated aptitude or achievement; such things as academic record and extracurricular activities are important.
- The applicant must have demonstrated outstanding citizenship such as having been active in community affairs.
- The applicant must submit an essay describing why they are deserving of the Dr. Michael A. Parlato Scholarship award.
- Applicant employment is preferred but not required.

Application Procedure

The applicant is required to submit a completed application form provided by the Dr. Michael A. Parlato Scholarship Fund Selection Committee. The application and all other required material must be postmarked no later than **April 30th** of the year for which the applicant is seeking scholarship assistance. Faxes are not accepted. The following materials must be submitted:

1. An official transcript of the applicant's secondary school record, complete to the last full marking period, must be mailed to the Selection Committee prior to the closing date of acceptance of applications. This transcript must come directly from the school.
2. An essay from the applicant outlining his or her reasons for applying for this scholarship must accompany the application and should include specific examples of contributions to the community and citizenship as well as address character, attitude, academic standing, employment, extracurricular activities and any significant reasons why you should be considered. Please limit your responses to one page.

3. Financial aid package information from your college/university **must** be submitted. If not available at time of submission, please indicate the date and forward to us by or before **April 30th**.
4. A completed copy of the **Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)** form that includes the **Student Aid Report (SAR)** with the **Expected Family Contribution (EFC)** information must accompany this application.
